

Gerad Crawford Memorial Scholarship

Guidelines

About the Scholarship:

The purpose of the Gerad Crawford Memorial Scholarship is to honor and remember our beloved, son and brother. Gerad had a heart for people, and was always willing to lend a hand when needed, to be an encouragement and support. This scholarship is open to all high school seniors, but special consideration will be given for any student pursuing track and field, a career in the culinary arts, or a degree in Art.

The scholarship is made possible through the proceeds generated from donations to the Gerad Crawford Memorial Scholarship.

Applicants need to read the guidelines and application in its entirety and be sure to complete all areas.

Eligibility: To be eligible for consideration, the student must:

- A. Be a senior in good standing at Kellogg High School who currently meets all criteria for graduation.
- B. Have a cumulative grade point average of 2.75 or above for all class work.
- C. Be in the process of applying for acceptance as a part time/full time student at a Jr. College, University or Trade School.
- D. Be a United States citizen or legal resident.

Selection Criteria:

Scholarship recipients will be selected on the following basis:

- A. General school records
- B. Community involvement and service.
- C. Years of attendance in Kellogg School District.
- D. Sincere desire and determination to further their education and training to attain a career in chosen field.
- E. Individual achievements (work experience, leadership roles, extra-curricular activities).
- F. 3 letters of recommendation (one from a teacher, one from a non-family member (coach, teacher, Pastor etc.), one from someone you have worked for in a job or community service environment).

Amount and use:

The amount of the scholarship is determined by the availability of funds. For 2018, at least one \$1,000 scholarship will be given. Half of the Scholarship (\$500) will be awarded for the Fall Semester of 2018 and the second half (\$500) will be awarded for the Spring Semester of 2019. A minimum GPA of 2.75 must be maintained in order to remain eligible for the scholarship in the second Semester.

Scholarship funds will be disbursed through the higher education institution and are contingent on evidence of enrollment. No distribution will be made directly to the recipient. Funds from the scholarship are to be used for tuition and fees, books and supplies, associated room and board expenses.

His letterman's jacket was proudly displayed with hard earned medals and you could hear them jingle when he walked.

One of the great loves of his life was cooking. To watch Gerad create in the kitchen was something to behold. He started his career in the culinary industry in 1986 at the Coeur d'Alene Resort and from there he flourished and grew in his craft.
